Acceptable items that are free

- Household Waste (must be in bags)
- Green Waste (must be in bags)
- Construction and Demolition
- Scrap metal
- E-Waste Recycling

The following items will cost and must be paid at drop off- CASH ONLY.

- Mattress/Box Spring/Couch- \$25.00 Each
- Passenger Tires w/out rim \$10.00 Each
- Passenger Tires w/rim \$18.00 Each
- Commercial Truck Tires w/out rim \$20.00 Each
- Commercial Truck Tires w/rim \$38.00 Each
- **WE DO NOT ACCEPT TIRES LARGER THAN COMMERCIAL TRUCK TIRES**
- Appliances w/ out freon \$25.00 Each

***Property owner/s shall take advantage of this event as Article 6 of the California Valley Community Services District Solid Waste Ordinance States the following;**

ARTICLE 6

CLEARING OF ACCUMULATED SOLID WASTE AND RUBBLE:

6.1 The accumulation of solid waste, refuse, and/or rubble in violation of Article 6 is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

6.2 The District's Operations Supervisor is authorized and empowered to notify the owner, his/or her agent, or person in control of any lot or parcel within the District, and direct them to dispose of solid waste, refuse, and/or rubble that has accumulated in violation of Article 6. Such notice shall be given by posting the lot or parcel by certified mail addressed to the owner, his or her agent, at his or her last known address or by personal service on the owner, agent, person in control, or occupant of the property.

6.3 The notice shall describe the work to be done and shall state if the work is not commenced within 10 calendar days after receipt of notice and diligently prosecuted to completion without interruption, the District Operations Supervisor shall notify the County Environmental Health Department to commence abatement proceedings. **The cost of said abatement, including administrative costs and attorney's fees, shall be a lien on the property.**

No person shall allow the following to accumulate on developed and undeveloped (vacant) property:

- (a) Solid Waste;
- (b) Rubble; or
- (c) Cast Offs

Refuse: "Refuse" includes garbage, recyclables, green waste, castoffs, and/or rubble.

Rubble: "Rubble" means and includes all debris from the construction, demolition, or alteration of Building, earth, rocks, or incinerator ashes, brick, mortar, concrete, and similar solid material.

Solid Waste: "Solid Waste" means and includes all waste substances including garbage, green waste, and recyclables, but does not include cast-offs or rubble.

Cast Offs: "Cast Offs" means items such as mattresses, couches, chairs, refrigerators, and other household furniture, but does not include rubble or solid waste.
